Latest Changes and Requirements in Fall Protection Regulations

Recently MIOSHA rescinded the Alternatives to Conventional Fall Protection for Residential Construction. This changes the requirements for fall protection for contractors engaged in residential construction.

- Falls accounted for 29 percent of construction workplace fatalities investigated by MIOSHA over the past five years.
- The number one cause of death and serious injury at residential construction sites is falls by employees working above the ground on roofs, ladders and scaffolding.
- This training does qualify for continuing education credit for licensed builders.
- **AVOID FINES** – Attend training before enforcement begins in December!
